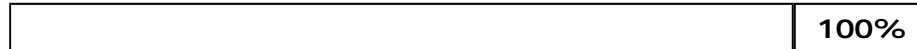


## 2009 GOC Green Neighborhood Council Scorecard

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## 1. 2009 Green Neighborhood Scorecard



The Green Neighborhood Scorecard is a survey distributed each year by the Green Neighborhood Council of the Green Omaha Coalition to determine the environmental friendliness of Omaha neighborhoods. Participation is voluntary, but residents are encouraged to complete this survey for their neighborhoods and submit it online by August 15, 2009.

Scorecards will be evaluated and ranked on levels of "green-ness." The greenest neighborhoods will be announced on September 19, 2009 at Village Point Farmers Market during kickoff of the Green Omaha Coalition's Green Homes Tour.
